2. GOD'S MISSION BRINGS <u>SATISFACTION</u>. JOHN 4:27-34

"My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to accomplish his work."

"Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord." **Philippians 3:8 (ESV)**

"Just then his disciples came back. They were shocked. They couldn't believe he was talking with that kind of a woman. No one said what they were all thinking, but their faces showed it. The woman took the hint and left. In her confusion she left her water pot."

1) Are there things in your life right now that are distracting you from experiencing the true satisfaction and joy of being on mission with Jesus?

APPLICATION QUESTION:

1) Are we willing to give it all up, if necessary, to join Him in His mission?
